



# SCOUT SLEEPOVER GUIDE



### Fees:

- \$525 for up to 15 scouts & 5 adults
- \$35 per additional scout
- \$5 per additional adult

\*Max 25 scouts/tag-a-longs. Please note, any tag-a-longs that participate in the badge activities will be counted as scouts.

### Reserving a Date:

All scout sleepovers can be booked directly online at [www.sml.org/scouts](http://www.sml.org/scouts). Sleepovers can be booked up to 5 months in advance. The full \$525 base price must be paid to secure your troops' sleepover date.

### Date Changes/Cancellations:

Requests to change the date/cancel scout a sleepover within 30 days are subject to a \$50 admin fee. SMLI cannot guarantee availability for switching dates.

Any cancellations made on the day of a scheduled sleepover are not eligible for refunds or credits, except for emergency situations. These situations are considered on a case-by-case basis. **Please note that scout sleepovers take place rain or shine.**

### Badge Programs:

From 6:00-7:30pm, scouts will work on a badge program that has been pre-selected by the troop leader. All currently available badge programs can be viewed on our website at [www.sml.org/scouts](http://www.sml.org/scouts). Please note that SMLI **does not** provide badge patches.

## SLEEPOVER SCHEDULE

### FRIDAY

- 5:00pm Troop arrives, settles in & has dinner
- 6:00 - 7:30pm Badge Program
- 7:30 - 8:00pm Troop prepares for night hike & campfire.
- 8:00 - 9:30pm Night hike & campfire

### SATURDAY

- Troop has breakfast & packs up
- 8:00 - 9:00am Beach Walk at Manhasset Bay
- 9:00am Troop departs

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### IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

#### **Arrival & Parking:**

Troops should follow signs for 'Staff Parking' after arriving at 1526 North Plandome Road. Cars can be parked in any available spot in the lot. **Please do not block in any cars, as they may belong to SMLI staff who have not left for the day.** If the lot is full, cars can park temporarily to unload supplies before heading down and parking in our visitor parking lot.

#### **What to Bring:**

Troops are responsible for dinner, breakfast (see below) and smore's ingredients for the campfire. SMLI recommends closed toe shoes for the night hike and morning beach walk. All participants should be dressed appropriately for the weather, taking into account the chillier temperatures for the night hike & morning beach walk. A television with a DVD player will be available if troops would like to bring a movie for scouts to enjoy at night.

*\*Do not bring: alcoholic beverages, large sums of cash/valuables.*

#### **Dinner & Breakfast:**

Troops are responsible for bringing/arranging dinner and breakfast. A microwave and fridge will be available to troops for sleepovers to store any food/water bottles. Dinner can either be brought in or delivered from a local restaurant (ordering in advance is highly suggested). SMLI recommends Ginof of Manhasset (516.627.9400) for dinner. Common breakfast choices include cereal & bagels.

#### **Sleeping Areas:**

Two rooms will be made available to troops for scout sleepovers. The Gallery (see photo below) will be set up with tables & chairs for dining purposes, and the Theater (see photo below) will be left clear for sleeping arrangements. A combination of sleeping bags and minimal air mattresses can be set up. There are plenty of outlets in both rooms for inflating air mattresses. Troops can move/collapse tables & chairs in the Gallery if additional space is required.

#### **Gift Shop:**

SMLI's gift shop can be made available to troops on Saturday morning prior to departure. We accept all forms of payment, including Venmo and ApplePay.
